Note: The following classes are **not** offered: Amateur Owner Handler, Novice, Stud, Brood, and Brace.

Bred-by-Exhibitor (BBE) Class will be for dogs individually registered with AKC and must be shown by the breeder and owner of record. This class is divided into two age groups consisting of Puppy, for dogs that are six months of age but under twelve months, and Adult, for dogs that are twelve months of age and older. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class or divisions of it becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle. Winners from the BBE Class will be counted toward the BBE medallion. In addition, the Puppy division of the BBE class will be added to the list of classes in which points toward the Puppy of Achievement Certificate may be earned

(Additional Classes Involving single dog entries)

Veteran Dog Class will be for Dogs 7 years old and over. 1st place Dog will compete in BOB.

Veteran Bitch Class will be for Bitches 7 years old and over. 1st place Bitch will compete in BOB. The club has elected to allow neutered dogs or spayed bitches to compete in Veteran classes.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The Judge will award up to 4 Awards of Merit and Select Dog/Bitch following Best of Breed Judging.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES COMPETITION

Must be owner-handled by a non-professional handler. Must be marked on entry form at time of entry. Follows Best of Breed Judging.

BEST IN BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR will be held following the Best of Breed competition of each of the Shows. 1st place Dogs & Bitches from the BBE classes or divisions will compete. If Best of Winners is a Bred-By, they are automatically Best in Bred-by-Exhibitor.

BEST PUPPY IN SHOW will be held following the Best of Breed competition of each of the Shows. 1st place Dogs & Bitches from the Puppy classes or divisions will compete. If Best of Winners is a Puppy, they are automatically Best Puppy in Show.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH (Beginner Puppy) COMPETITION

Must be handled by a non-professional handler. AKC Registration OR Litter Number. Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. Males with undescended testicles need NOT be excused but POA points will be withheld. No taping, gluing or stitching allowed in the ring. Class NOT divided by sex.

Parade of Champions, Title Holders, Veterans, Rescues (Non-Competitive)

Dogs entered in this class need not be entered in a Regular Class. This class will not be judged. Cut downs welcome. A history of the dog, limited to 50 words is required. Each dog will receive a ROSETTE IMPRINTED with his/her name.

THE SHOWROOM will be open from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

AKC \$5.00 EVENT SERVICE FEE for the first entry of a dog and a **\$5.00 service fee** for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, and a **RECORDING FEE OF \$.50** will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. A **\$3.00 Event Service Fee** for the Four-to-Six Month Puppy Class will be required for each puppy entered. This Recording/Event Service Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2). *These fees are already included in the entry fees listed!*

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received.

MAKE ALL CHECKS and MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE to WMYTC: Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through mail.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS: Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3).
